Andreas began his career as the Manager-in-Charge of the worldwide logistics operations of the Coffee Division of the Volkart / VOLCAFE Group. Later he was also responsible for special operations, which included barter deals and the integration of newly acquired overseas subsidiaries.

From 2000 to 2004 he served as a member and later as Chairperson of the MBA Alumni Loan & Scholarship Committee of IMD in Lausanne.
